- Exploring a variety of musical styles and sounds with clients through singing, percussion, ethnic instruments, and improvisation
- Maintaining records and documentation
- Reporting progress to families, caregivers, relevant agencies, or professional staff

- Bachelor's (or higher) degree in music therapy
- MT-BC (Board Certified Music Therapist) or to be obtained within 60 days of hire
